What do you **DISLIKE** about the proposed design?

- All person trial having access behind the school making it easy for anyone to stalk/lurk around the school and have easier access to children. Increased safety risk especially in case of emergency
- How often will the baseball field or soccer field be used when the town doesn't have a league for kids or adults? My question is about broader use and what to prioritize.
- Grass Parking between courts
- Baseball and soccer — youth leagues are nonexistent. Unless this would bring revenue to the town for league rentals, they'd be underused.
- The original boardwalks were placed decades ago and were never properly placed or maintained, becoming worn, uneven, and unsafe. Installing something like that needs a maintenance reserve fund. Volunteers don't work long term.
- Too many town resources with 3 DPW personnel is put into this field. The Town of Clarksburg is SMALL and has FEW businesses to help contribute to costs.

- Against all persons trail in and around school. Safety concern. Easy accessible for stalking and people lurking around children. HUGE liability
- The one lane road. Unlikely to help with pick up process and adds more cars/roads around kids at school for potential issues.
- Need safe route from school to emergency center
- The optional road...I don't like the idea of cars potentially driving up through the school playground during recess.
- The one way exit would work, but potential for people using it inappropriately is something to consider. It's remote, close behind neighbors houses. Maybe installing a gate and closing it at the end of the day and on weekends to keep it private.
- A rear drop off would require 3 and 4 years old to navigate a significant number of stairs to exit the building. Students in youngest grades would have to walk the farthest for dismissal. The number of staff needed to dismiss in the back would increase, absences could make it tricky. Also far from main office which would make it difficult for last minute dismissal changes and calls that often need to be made to confirm.
- I dislike the optional road. It would be really sad to knock down the beautiful trees and bring more cement and noise into the woods. The drop off and pick up for school isn't currently perfect but I would much rather have the current situation than have something that slightly speeds up the congestion while costing a lot of money to damage the woods.

- No trails — even around the pollinator meadow would be nice or a 0.5 mile loop for tracking movement.
- Who will keep all the new sidewalks clear is the winter?? Sand and salt runoff?? This will be emergency evacuation for the school.
- I don't have strong feelings as my family won't be at an age where we use the senior center for more than voting for a couple of decades.
- The Community Center was built with grant funding. Now it has become a taxpayer cost. I must say that the parking lot has the best black top while our roads collapse. Backwards thinking.
- Calling it a "community center" is a joke. It's the senior center, they do not and are not willing or accepting on anyone in the community using the facility. Would be a great place to have children's birthday parties or family gatherings. With the way it's set up now that's impossible to do and jump through all of their hoops to be considered. If they are unwilling to give up control then there is no reason to waste money on making improvements because how it is now suits the seniors adequately
- Taking away double driveway where signage now goes

- Additional full-loop walking trail, perhaps gravel for multipurpose use. Ideally, .5 mile if feasible with acreage.
